2022 Rebate Application

Program Rules

- The member is responsible for checking with the cooperative to determine funding availability and resolve questions on program rules.
 - Installation must be complete before application is submitted and rebate funds are issued.
 - Rebates must be applied for within 12 months of invoice date.
 - The cooperative reserves the right to conduct random inspections of installations.
 - Rebate subject to availability.
 - Limit one EV-ready circuit incentive per home.

- Minimum circuit ampacity: 40 amps
 - Wire must run between a 2-gang junction box in the garage and the homes electrical panel in accordance with National Electrical Code.
 - Connecting the wire to a circuit breaker in the electrical service is not required nor is installing a 240-volt receptacle in the garage.
 - Junction box requires Future EV Circuit sticker, supplied by McLeod Coop Power, to be applied.
